IIM Calcutta Alumni Association Mumbai Launches Clarion Call 4.0; Invites Start-Ups Across The Country To Compete

Kolkata: IIM Calcutta Alumni Association (IIMCAA) Mumbai, announces the fourth edition of India's largest start-up events, Clarion Call 4.0. This year, the event is organized in association with IIM Calcutta Innovation Park (IIMCIP) - a body established under the aegis of IIM Calcutta to promote entrepreneurship and innovation. Clarion Call 4.0 will consist of mentorships and masterclasses from leading entrepreneurs and industry stalwarts and deserving startups will be funded by eight best Angel Networks and several Venture Capitalists.
