The Indian Institute of Management, Calcutta organised the second phase of the Covid -19 vaccination drive on campus today for its students, staff and faculty along with their family members. A total of 393 persons were vaccinated at the camp with the first and second dose of Covishield and Covaxin vaccines. The day-long vaccination camp was organized in partnership with Pulse Diagnostics, with due permission from the Chief Medical Officer of Health, South 24 Parganas, Government of West Bengal.

The vaccination doses were administered at the New Academic Block (NAB) Building/Amphitheatre at the Joka premises. The institute had launched the first phase of the vaccination drive on 7th June 2021 where 296 persons including faculty members, officers, staff and their family members along with contractual employees were vaccinated.
