The <u>Indian Institute of Management</u>, <u>Ahmedabad</u> (IIM-A) concluded the convocation ceremony with 380 students from the two year Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGP) graduating this year.

In addition to the 380 students from the two year Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGP), 48 from the two year Post Graduate Programme in Food and Agribusiness Management (PGP-FABM); 140 from one year Post Graduate Programme in Management for Executives (PGPX) and 29 from the PhD programme in Management (PhD) graduated from IIM Ahmedabad.

The IIM-A had also recently concluded its <u>MBA placements for the class of 2023</u> of the Post Graduate Programme (PGP) in Management. This year, 188 firms participated with around 280 roles. IIM-A conducted the placements in two stages – the first was the laterals process, in which firms interviewed students with prior work experience and offered them mid-level managerial positions. The second stage was where firms were grouped into cohorts based on their core business, and groups of cohorts were invited to campus across different clusters. This stage saw 106 applications.
